Bridging Service for Grace Bonow


Grace Bonow, Guest Speaker Nancy Philip, Worship Associate

Cedars' Annual Congregational Meeting

Our Annual Congregational Meeting is on June 8, directly after the service. During this meeting, members will be able to vote on important agenda items. All Members and Friends are welcome to attend. Here's the Agenda.



We will be voting on:

- Adopting the presented 2025-2026 budget. The Board and the Budget Leadership
 Team have worked hard to present a budget that will allow us to maintain Cedars
 programs and look toward growth in the coming year. LINKS: Budget Leadership

- Voting on Board of Trustees Candidates: Rod Kempkes' term expires this year, but
 he is willing to extend his term one more year. We will vote on an extension to his
 term. We will also vote on a 2-year term for Tyler Weaver who will replace Andrea
 Barnes, whose term expires this year.
- Voting on Nominating Committee Candidates: We will vote on 2-year terms for Jane Martin and Dean Sampson.

It is very important that we have a quorum at this meeting so that the votes are valid. We need 30% of our members to attend. Therefore, we want and need as many people attending as possible.


Mortal-i-tea with Johanna Munson and the EdgeWalking Collective


