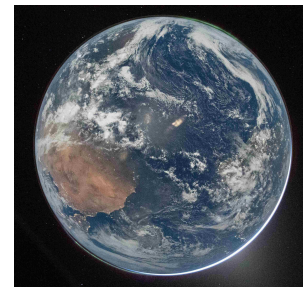
Celebrating Earth Day

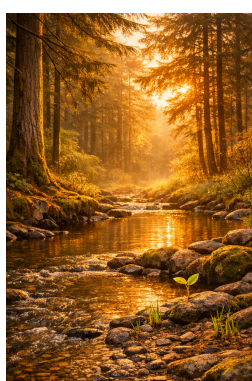

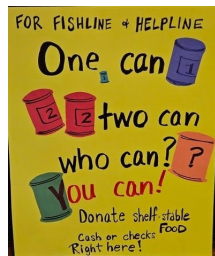
April 19th Special Collection: Third Act

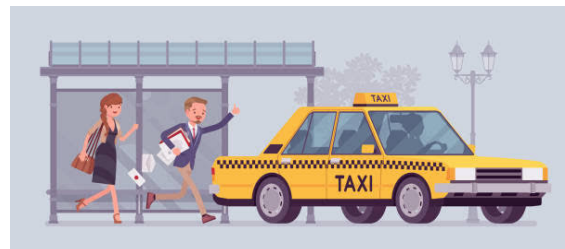

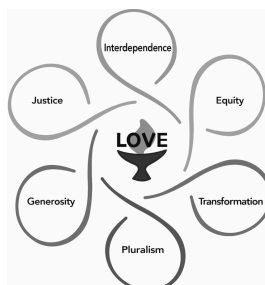
